Mrs. Mary Elizabeth Simpson "Dixie" Whitaker, 101, of Carthage, Texas was born February 2, 1919 in Taylorville, Illinois. She passed this life April 27, 2020 peacefully at her Carthage, Texas home. She was one of three children born to the marriage of Ritchie Reman and Mary Louise Scott Simpson. Dixie was raised in Illinois graduating high school in Taylorville and attending University of Chicago and North Western University. She worked for Marshall Fields and the Chicago Farmers Magazine.

Dixie Simpson met Fred Whitaker in Chicago on a blind date; they would hold a Texas wedding that June. Together they raised four children and made a life in his home town of Carthage, Texas. Dixie's life in Texas would be as a staunch member of the Democratic Party. She was a founder and second president of the Junior Service League, supporting the Sammy Brown Library and member of the First United Methodist Church of Carthage. She was an avid bridge player, loved entertaining, working in her garden and time with family and friends. She is preceded in death by her parents; brother, Andy Simpson; and sister, Caroline Rogers.
