Dr. Abdul Amir Jabir Hummadi was born August 20, 1931 in Hillah, Iraq to Jabir Hummadi and Basha Said Abid. He was raised in the Middle East and moved to the States to attend Oklahoma State University in Stillwater, OK, where he received his Doctorate of Veterinary Medicine. He met and later married Veronica Brooks on June 3, 1956 and together they celebrated 58 years of marriage. Hummadi retired from the U.S. Dept. of Agriculture Food Industry. He was a member of the Carthage Lions Club. Dr. Hummadi was preceded in death by his grandson, Jonathan Pagan; sister, Gorjia Jabir and sister and brother-in-law Zainab and Mehdi Azzawi.
