



## Mrs. Anita Everett

November 1, 1933 - July 16, 2016

Funeral services for Mrs. Anita Everett, 82 of Carthage, Texas will be 2:00 p.m., Tuesday, July 26, 2016 at Central Baptist Church with Rev. Joe Orr and Dr. Tommy Sanders officiating. Burial will follow in Odd Fellows Cemetery under the direction of Hawthorn Funeral Home. A viewing will be Monday, July 25, 2016 from 6 – 8:00 p.m. at the funeral home and visitation with the family will be Tuesday, July 26, 2016 from 11:30–12:30 p.m. in the parlor of Central Baptist Church. Mrs. Everett passed away July 16, 2016 at her home in Carthage.

Mrs. Anita June Scott Everett was born November 1, 1933 in Goodlett, Texas to Louis and Irene Collier Scott. The oldest of two children, Anita attended Denison schools graduating with the Class of 1951. She furthered her education at East Texas Baptist University, graduating in 1957 with a degree in Elementary Education. Anita married the love of her life, William Clarence Everett on June 19, 1954 and together they celebrated 62 years of marriage. Mrs. Everett, an elementary school teacher, also devoted her time to being a church secretary and playing the organ, while ministering to churches where Dr. Everett was preaching. She was preceded in death by her parents.

Mrs. Everett is survived by her husband, Dr. W.C. “Bill” Everett of Carthage; son, James Ross “Jay” Everett and wife Beth of Arlington; daughter, Laurie G. Everett Lindloff and husband Andy of Carlsbad, CA; sister, Louise Heironamus of Denison; grandchildren, Julianna Lindloff and Amy Elizabeth and Ross Everett, numerous other relatives and a host of friends.

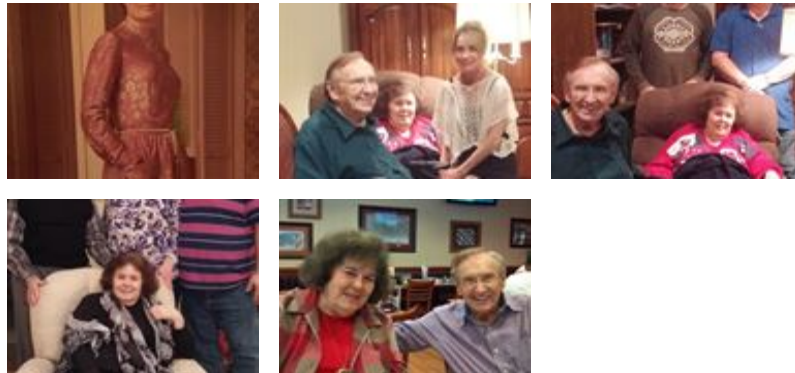
