We shared about our families and all our troubles and cried on each other's shoulder when we needed to. There wasn't anything that I needed that she would not do. She holds a very special place in my heart.

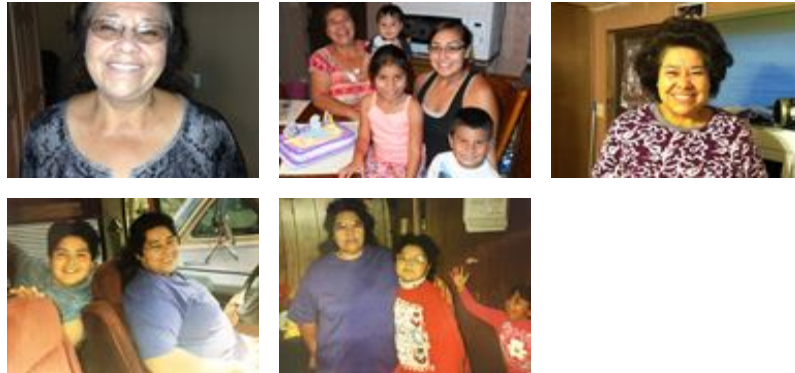
She was not just an employee, she was a friend, a companion and a loving caretaker for Austin. We will miss her deeply.
