Beatrice Betts Anderson, 93, went to be with her Lord and Savior on September 29, 2023, in Plano, Texas.

Mrs. Anderson was born on January 7, 1930, in Memphis, Tennessee, being one of two daughters born to the marriage of Edwin Hulbert and Mable Young Betts. Her parents later adopted twins, sister Connie Guraedy and brother Carl Betts. Bea attended school in Conroe, Texas and married Willie Lee Welch December 23, 1947. They had two sons and a daughter together. She later married Noble Anderson of Carthage, November 19, 1956. They were married 43 years before he preceded her in death in 1999.
