Mr. Billy R. Cranford of Carthage, Texas, age 90, passed peacefully at home in Aztec, NM on September 17, 2019. Visitation for Mr. Billy R. Cranford will be 6-8:00 p.m. at the Hawthorn Funeral Home on Saturday, September 21, 2019. Graveside services will be 2:00 p.m. Sunday, September 22, 2019 at Walton Cemetery, with Dr. Dale Reed officiating.

Billy Ray Cranford was born January 28, 1929 in Panola County, Texas. He was the 7th of 9 children born to the marriage of William Lee and Catherine Elma Holt Cranford. Billy Ray married the love of his life, Faye June Chapman Cranford January 10, 1951 in Cusseta, Chattahoochee County, Georgia.
