



Mr. Billy "Pee Wee" Morris

Mr. Billy Ray Morris was born January 18, 1936 in Marshall, Texas and passed away April 5, 2018 in the Rock Hill Community. He was raised and schooled in Panola County graduating from Beckville High School with the class of 1956 and later attended Panola College. Billy proudly served his country in the United States Army. 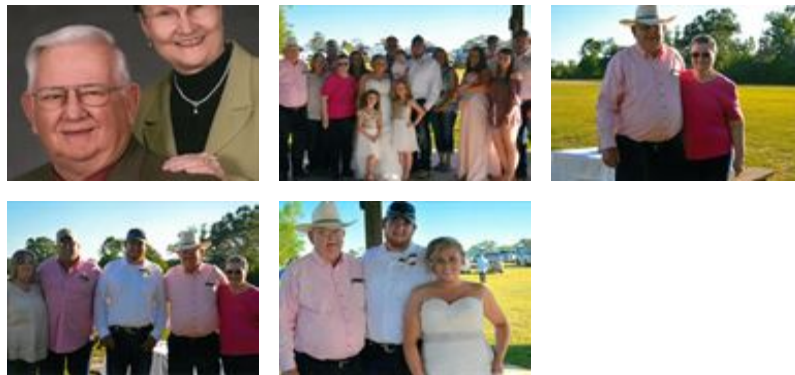
