For now even though I don't want to, I will say rest in peace until I see you again. I will miss you so much my friend and I love you. A piece of my heart went with you.





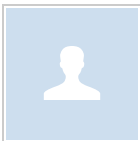

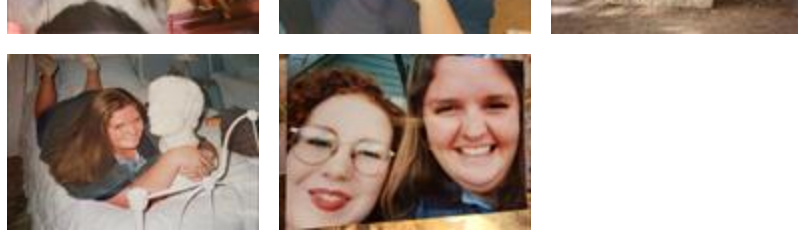

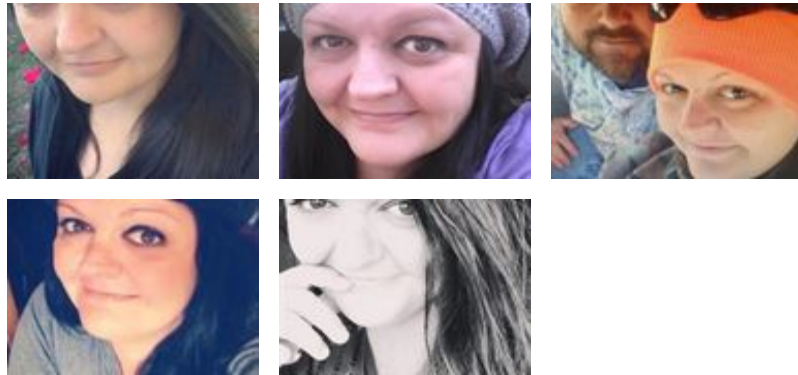
