Funeral service for Mr. Calvin Wallace, 91 of Katy, Texas, will be held on Friday, April 7, 2023, at 10:00 a.m. at the Hawthorn Funeral Home Chapel with Rev. Dale Walker officiating. Mr. Calvin Wallace was born on August 13, 1931, in Smackover, Arkansas. He passed this life on March 31, 2023, surrounded by his family. They married on August 4, 1951, and were married 70 years. They had two children, Patti and Richard. They lived there until 2014 when they moved to Katy to be closer to family. Calvin loved his family and always put others before himself. He was a very active 91-year-old and drove his great granddaughters to and from school every day. He was Cinco Ranch High School baseball's number one fan, and never missed a game supporting his grandson, Coach Brett Wallace. He rarely missed the sporting events of his children, grandchildren, and great grandchildren. He loved spending time with family and friends. One of the highlights every summer was the annual trip to the lake, and he enjoyed celebrating family birthdays and holidays. He was affectionately known as Pop.
