Cecil Ray Blair, 83, of Carthage, Texas passed away on November 9, 2024 surrounded by loved ones in Carthage, Texas. 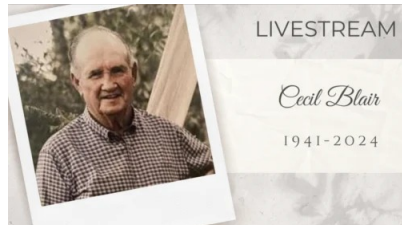

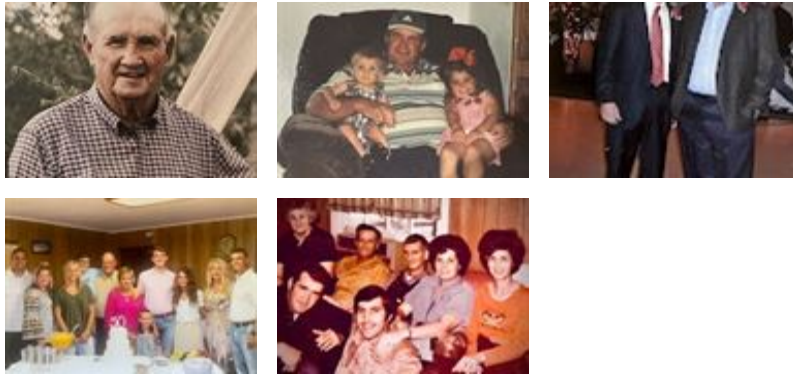
