Funeral services for Mr. Cecil Portman, Jr., 78, of Carthage, Texas will be 2:00 p.m. Sunday, January 31, 2021 at the Hawthorn Funeral Home Chapel with The Rev. Jennene Laurinec and Bro. Mr. Cecil Hayward Portman was born October 23, 1942 in Texarkana, Texas. He passed this life January 27, 2021 in Carthage, Texas. Cecil was born to the marriage of Cecil Hayward and Mary Lou White Portman. He was raised throughout the states of California, Louisiana, and Texas, graduating from New Boston High School with the class of 1960. He attended Texarkana Junior College, East Texas State University, Panola College, Kilgore College, and graduated Stephen F. Austin State University in 1970 with a Bachelor of Science and Business Administration.

Mr. Portman served his country through the U. S. Air Force honorably discharged as an Airman First Class. Cecil married his love, Gloria Jean Reeves February 8, 1964 and they celebrated almost 57 years of marriage. Cecil continued his service, working for the Dept. of Public Welfare over 20 years, achieving the status of Quality Control Reviewer, one of only 11 in the state of Texas for the U.S. Dept. of Health, Education and Welfare. His service continued as a Veteran Benefits Administrator serving in Waco, Texas. Cecil loved a challenge, political conversation over coffee, H.A.M. radio

operations, and spending time with all his in-laws and nephew and niece he loved as his own. He is preceded in death by his parents.

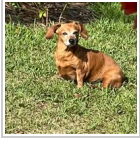
