



## Mr. Chad Escoe

Mr. Chad Davis Escoe was born November 12, 1944 in the Davis family home in Carthage, Texas. He passed this life June 18, 2020 in Austin, Texas. Chad was the second of four children born to the marriage of Thomas Ewell and Elizabeth Anne Davis Escoe, Jr. He was raised and schooled in Carthage graduating with the Bulldog class of 1963 and went on to Southwest State Teachers College (TSU).
