



Mr. Charles Wesley Jones

January 11, 1930 - November 22, 2019

Graveside funeral services for Mr. Charles Wesley Jones, 89, of Kingwood, Texas will be 11:00 a.m. Friday, December 6, 2019 at the Gary Cemetery with Dr. Dale Reed officiating. Mr. Charles Wesley was born January 11, 1930 in Gary, Texas. The doctor that delivered rode a horse into the Gary countryside through 18 inches of snow. He passed this life November 22, 2019 in Kingwood, Texas. Charles was born to the marriage of Charles Edward and Mae Belle Hodges Jones. He was raised and schooled in Gary graduating as the valedictorian of the class of 1947. He lettered four years in basketball and played softball.

Mr. Jones began his career moving to Houston, working for the accounting dept. of Gulf Oil Corp. He attended night school to get a diploma in business and accounting. Charles would travel to Longview to visit a girl by the name of Jennette Camilla Shadowens.

After several years of travel, he talked her into marriage and moving to Houston. They were married October 15, 1950 at St. Mark's United Methodist Church.

Charles received a letter to serve his country on January 11, 1951. After basic training they moved to San Antonio. They would have a son Kim Wesley born in the Brooks Army Hospital in 1952. Charles served two years in the 307th Military Police Battalion during the Korean War, discharged in February of

1953.

Working for United Gas Corporation, his daughter Pamela Jean was born in St. Joseph Hospital in Houston in 1955. Charles still working and attending night school achieved a BBA degree in August of 1959. They moved to Shreveport, LA until 1969. United Gas Corp. spun off the gas distribution operations becoming "United Gas, Inc." Charles passed his CPA degree exam in 1974. He was promoted to Vice President and Controller of Entex's three state gas distribution operations. Charles retired from Entex (formerly United Gas) in 1995 after 41 years in the gas business. Charles enjoyed his retirement in Kingwood with Jennette as active members of the Seeker's Sunday School Class at Kingwood U.M.C. They spent time on hobbies, and attending grandchildren's ball games and traveling. He is preceded in death by his parents, wife, Jennette C. Jones; sister, Kathleen Barton; and son, Kim Wesley Jones.

Mr. Jones is survived by his devoted daughter, Pamela Jones-Fuentes and husband Tony; daughter-in-law, Mary Jones; grandchildren, Kyle Jones, Blake Jones, Phillip Jones, Elizabeth Fuentes and their spouses Megan, Holly, Meghan, and Jeremy McLaughlin; five great grandchildren, Claire, Olivia, Jacob, Ezekiel, Colbie, and Charlie Kaye; many other relatives and a host of friends.
