Her brother and his family encouraged her to move to Orange, Texas to get a job there. She worked for Consolidated Steel until she and Auvie married May 25, 1955 at West Orange Baptist Church in Orange. They went to Miami, Florida on their honeymoon. They lived in Nacogdoches, Midland, Baytown, and settled in Midland in September 1959. She was preceded in death by her parents, her son Stanley G. Bailey of Midland, her sisters, Mary Dean Parrott, Kittie Claire Tipps, and Jeanell Prior, her brothers, Weldon B. Keeling, Robert T. Keeling. George B.
