She was their only child, and they graciously cared for this cherished daughter. Dava relished the relationships she created over the years with her extended family, the First United Methodist Church of Carthage and Carthage Independent School District. She was a proud member of the Class of 1972. Following high school, she attended Panola College and Stephen F. Austin State University, receiving a degree which allowed her to be a part of so many lives as a speech therapist, special education and life skills teacher. Her students fondly called her "Ms. G" as she helped them navigate life's tasks which many of us take for granted. Ms. Giles taught for Shelbyville, Marshall, Westwood, Overton, and Longview ISDs. In addition she worked at the Bradshaw State Jail to further inmates' education.

Dava married Charles Dean Giles in 1976, and to that union their son, David Ross Giles, was born. He was definitely the light of her life. The Charles Ross and Fay Giles family circle enlarged with aunts and uncles, Judy & Duane Bauske, Nancy & Terry Roark, and Gene & Brenda Giles. She adored her nieces, Jennifer, Crista and Cara.

Years after Dava's dad passed away, Mrs. Sholmire married Robert D. Sharp, and her family expanded to include step-sisters Pam Allison, Becky Modisette and Donna Rollins. Step-brothers, Bobby Sharp and Jimmy Sharp and numerous nieces and nephews became dear to her.

When her stepfather passed away, Dava became caregiver for her mom, Louise. This afforded her the opportunity to spend more time with the Hooker side of the family. 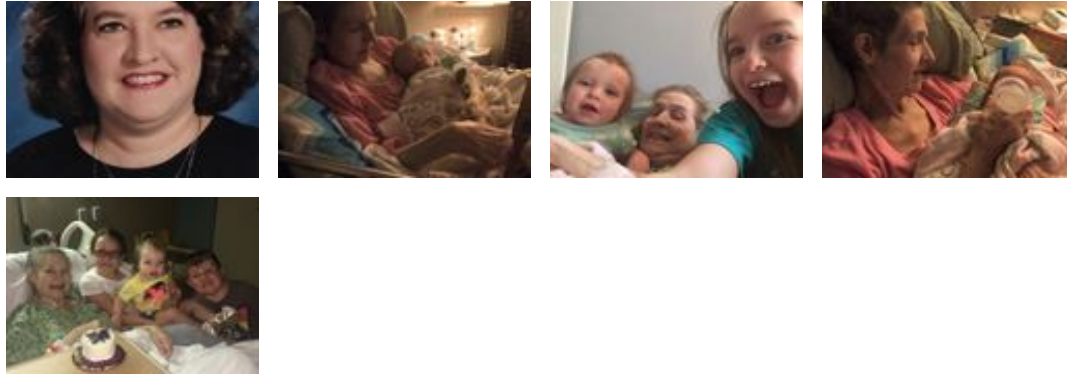
