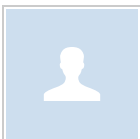

I am so sorry and saddened about David's untimely death. Believe it or not David crossed my mind several times during the days just prior to the accident and even the night before I got the call on Saturday. I am so glad Pat and I went to see him on Monday night. Although David and I haven't been in touch very much since we were young adults, and I do regret that, I always felt close kinship to him. I wish now we would have gotten together at least occassionally through the years and went hunting or checked our cows or talked about sports or just whatever. We really had a lot in common.

We were together a lot as children and young men in our natural prime. I have thought much about those days since David's death and have come to realize that his influence in those early formative years taught me a lot about life and living.

What I am going to write now is meant in an honest and positive way with complete respect and fondness for David. In my memory David had a unique and tough presence that was real and genuine to go along with a big heart that was not quite as obvious until you got to know him well. But it was there. He wa a free spirit who did things his way very effectively. He was also very independent. He was never pretentious or phony. With David what you saw was what you got. He taught me a lot from the school of hard knocks. You had to be pretty tough to follow David Crenshaw around. There was no place, time or pity for a momma's baby or a whiner. And believe me, just as in real life everything was not always fair. There was an age appropriate pecking order amongst the boy cousins, David, Richard, me and Pat. Sometimes I got pecked whether I deserved it or not. David also knew when to HOLD'EM and when to FOLD'EM and I am not talking about cards. On his cue, we escaped potential harm or disaster more than once when I was growing up. I learned from him that sometimes just calling it a day and going on home is a smart thing to do.

Personally David was gifted both physically and mentally. Intellectually he welcomed a challenge especially in math or science. He was also bold enough to challenge the accepted

*method or the popular opinion if he felt he had a better idea. He was an excellent student with a mind of his own. Physically David was remarkably powerful and skilled. To this day I have never seen a young man who could throw a baseball or spike a volleyball as hard as he could. He was also a crack shot with anything from a slingshot to a deer rifle.*

*In closing, I am thankful for David's influence on me as a child and a young man. It has served a positive purpose in my life that I am grateful for and will always cherish. Our escapades and adventures growing up challenged me and helped prepare for the real world looming in my future.*

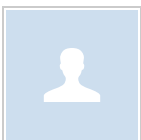

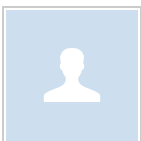

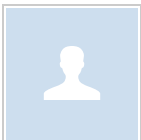
