David Amir Hummadi, 61, passed away, Sunday, October 21, 2018 in College Station, TX. David was born March 31, 1957 to Dr. Abdul Amir “Al” and Veronica Brooks Hummadi in Stillwater, OK, the oldest of four children. He graduated from Carthage High School in 1975 and Kilgore College in 1981 with an associate’s degree in oil and gas technology.
