



Mr. Dwight Taylor

Funeral services for Mr. Dwight “Fuddy” Taylor, 62 of Carthage, Texas will be 2:00 p.m., Sunday, August 23, 2015 at the Hawthorn Funeral Home Chapel with Rev. Dennis Landtroop and Rev. Mr. Taylor passed away August 20, 2015 in Tyler, Texas surrounded by his family.

Mr. Dwight Wayne “Fuddy” Taylor was born December 4, 1952 in Yorktown, Texas. He was one of two children born to Cecil Clifton and Hazel Virginia Dorn Taylor. Dwight graduated from Carthage High School and attended Panola College. He met and later married Lora Jane Luman on September 27, 1975 in Carthage and together they celebrated nearly 40 years. Dwight later worked as a Paramedic, worked for the Carthage Police Department and the Panola County Sheriff’s Office. He later furthered his education and received his Registered Nurse’s license from Tyler Junior College. Dwight was a member of the Carthage United Pentecostal Church and loved to go camping, playing the bass and singing. He loved life and loved making others laugh. Mr. Taylor is preceded in death by his parents.

Mr. Taylor is survived by his loving wife, Lora Taylor of Carthage; son, Stephen Luman and wife Donna of Timpson; brother, Mike Taylor and wife Rita of Ft. Worth; grandson Joshua Luman; numerous nieces, nephews, other relatives and a host of friends.

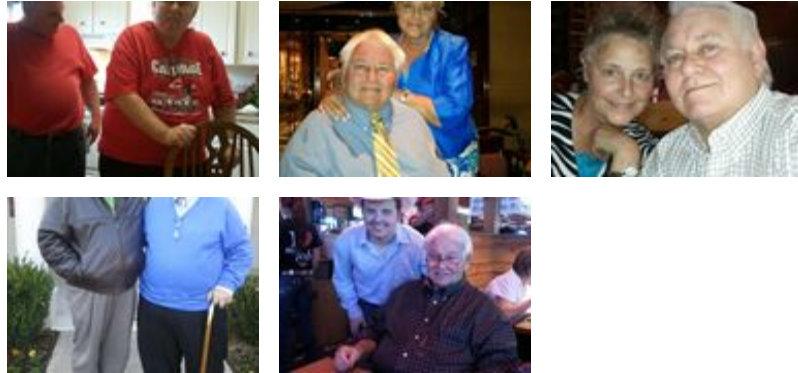
