Mrs. Edna Lorene Kyle Warf was born on Sunday, September 17, 1939, in the Old Center Community of Panola County, Texas. She passed this life peacefully on Thursday, September 29, 2022, at her Lake Cherokee home. She was one of six children born to the marriage of Sidney and Mayro Barron Kyle. Lorene was raised in Old Center. She began school in Tenaha, later graduating from Carthage High School with the Bulldog class of 1957. She graduated from Shreveport Vo-Tech where she obtained her nursing credentials. She married William "Bill" Guy Warf, March 15, 1958, and they celebrated 61 years of marriage and three children before he preceded her in death in 2019.
