Mr. Reid passed away on Sunday, June 28, 2015 at his home in Carthage.

Elbert Herman "Buck" Reid was born on January 22, 1926 in Kilgore, Texas to Vigil Lee and Ivy Grace Andrews Reid. He graduated from Kilgore High School. Buck married Ida Frances Baker in 1948 and they celebrated 67 wonderful years of marriage.

Buck and Frances loved traveling throughout the U.S. until they found a little piece of the Sangre De Cristo Mountains in Crestone, Colorado that they called home each summer. For twenty-eight years they spent many happy hours entertaining their children, grandchildren and friends in their little Blue Spruce home.

Buck was a faithful member of Central Baptist Church where he taught Sunday School, Training Union, RA's and worked with the youth. He and Frances were in fellowship at the Crestone Baptist Church, which was their church home during their summers in Crestone.

Buck was an avid sportsman enjoying fishing, quail hunting and riding in the mountains in his yellow jeep looking for elk. Many hours were spent training

his beautiful Brittany Spaniels, German Short Hairs and English Setters. The love of hunting was demonstrated with Buck asking Frances to postpone their wedding date until after bird season on January 15th.

Mr. Reid was a member of the Odd Fellows Lodge celebrating 60 plus years of active service. He worked for Continental Oil and Gas Refinery for 30 years as a plant processing operator. Buck was the diligent "Keeper" of the Dixie Lake for twenty plus years and served as the Board President. Many happy hours of fishing in the lake was enjoyed by Buck and his friends and family. Mr. Reid is survived by his loving wife, Ida Frances Reid; his two sons, Robbie Reid of Carthage and Randy and his wife Rose Helen Reid of Carthage; two brothers, Vigil Lee "Jr." and wife Sylvia Reid and Arthur Lyn and wife Glenda Reid both of Kilgore; grandchildren, Emilee Reid of Tyler, Julie and Chris Tiller of Bullard, Rhett and Beth Reid of Henderson, Lindsey and Anthony Hammett of Lorton, VA, Laurie and Mark Prihoda of Weimer; and many great grandchildren he adored. 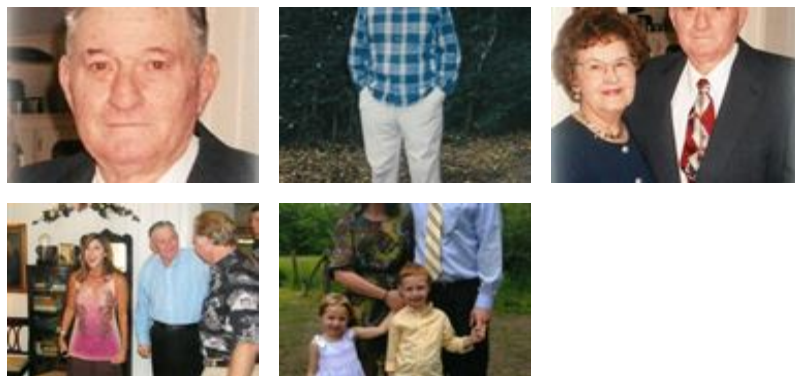
