Margaret Eugenia Gill Smith was born December 4, 1921, in Brashear, Texas to Robert Allen and Margaret Caroline Smith Gill. She spent most of her life in Carthage, graduating with the class of 1939. Eugenia then went on to Baylor University, where she met the love of her life, William Cecil "W.C." Smith, whom she later married on August 7, 1943. She was graduated from Baylor in 1943 with a Bachelor of Science in Home Economics. A homemaker, Eugenia was a long time member of Central Baptist Church where she worked with the GA's, was a leader of WMU, and was involved with the starting of the Church library. She participated in the early days of the Texas Tea Room and was a member of the Carthage Book Forum. Mrs. Smith loved to work with her hands doing very delicate cross-stitching, knitting and crocheting. She was preceded in death by her parents, sister and brother-in-law, Ruth and Jimmy Jacobs; brother-in-law, Jake Walker and son-in-law, Robert Reid.
