



Mr. Huey P. Ortigo

December 14, 1929 - March 23, 2020

Mr. Huey P. Ortigo was born December 14, 1929 in Kisatchie, Louisiana. He passed this life March 23, 2020 in Carthage, Texas. Huey was raised and schooled in Kisatchie, Louisiana then graduating high school in Natchitoches with the class of 1948. He attended Northwestern State University then joined the U. S. Navy. He served almost 5 years during the Korean War. Mr. Ortigo married Georgia Elaine Baker June 3, 1954 and they celebrated almost 66 years of marriage.

Mr. Ortigo owned and operated Ortigo Sheetmetal and Roofing. He worked for Metropolitan Life Ins. Co. and worked as an independent truck driver until the age of 75. He was a longtime member of the Logan Assembly of God, loved farming, ranching, and gardening, and baseball. He is preceded in death by his parents, siblings, William Kile Ortigo, Vernice Ortigo, Marie Bivens, Arvil "Ted" Ortigo, and Eddie Lee Fox.
