Mr. James Wolsey "Pete" Williams was born December 19, 1928, in Gary, Texas. He passed this life February 9, 2022, peacefully at his Carthage home. Pete was one of thirteen children born to the marriage of Dudley and Myrtis Melinda Nolan Williams. He was raised and completed schools in Gary, Texas. Mr. Williams served his country through the U.S. Army. He married Shirley Ann Hayes October 29, 1961, and they celebrated 60 years of marriage and three children.

Mr. Williams began his career in television repair in 1954 and came to own and operate the Williams T.V. Repair. 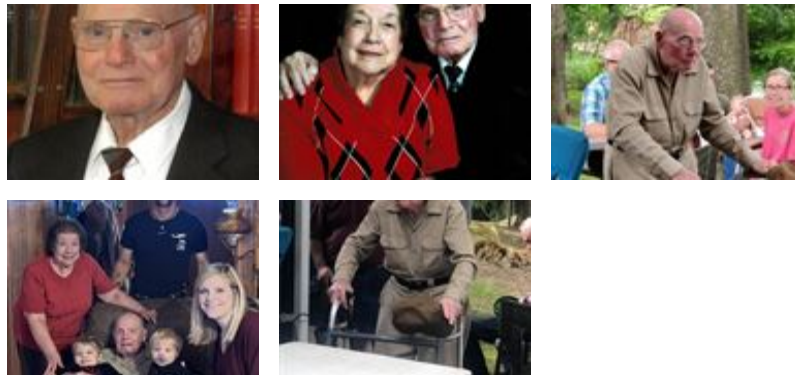
