



## Mr. James "Ronny" Jeter

June 3, 1953 - January 12, 2017

Mr. James Ronald "Ronny" Jeter was born June 3, 1953 in Carthage, Texas. He was one of three children born to the marriage of James Clifford and Robbie Jean Ivy Jeter. He graduated Carthage high with the class of 1971, attended Panola College and graduated Stephen F. Austin with a Bachelors in Business. He was the owner/operator of Jeter's Junction store for over 30 years. Ronny married Elizabeth Jean Yeates April 25, 1981 and they celebrated 35 years together.

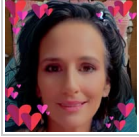
