Mr. Wedgeworth died Wednesday, December 14, 2011 in Tyler, Texas. Mr. James "Bill" Edward Wedgeworth was born March 27, 1931 in the Corinth Community of Shelby County, Texas. He was the second of seven children born to the marriage of Frank and Corine Nall Wedgeworth. Bill graduated from Timpson High School, later serving his country through the U.S. Army as a sergeant 1st class during the Korean war. He married Helen Sue Campbell July 23, 1955 and together they celebrated 56 years of marriage. Mr. Wedgeworth worked 36 years for Conoco Phillips as a plant manager in the gas production field, retiring in 1990. After retirement he became a full time cattle rancher. He earned the Conservation Farmer of the Year Award from the U.S.D.A. He loved quail hunting or anything outdoors. He was a member of the Central Baptist Church, a man who loved his Lord and family above all else. He is preceded in death by his parents and a brother, Bob Wedgeworth. 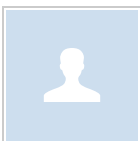
