Mrs. Lena Jenelle Jacobs Brooks of Carthage was born on December 5, 1925, in Iradell, Texas, to the union of the late Herman and Loise Reed Jacobs. Jenelle passed from this life on March 23, 2017, in Longview, Texas. Mrs. Brooks was a 1943 graduate of Carthage High School. She earned her undergraduate and Pharmacy Degrees at the University of Texas at Austin, where she completed her studies in 1948. She was a Registered Pharmacist for more than fifty years, and she proudly maintained her license throughout her life.

Mrs. Brooks was a lifelong member of the United Methodist Church. She was for many years a member of the First United Methodist Church of Carthage, where she faithfully attended as long as she was able.

She was the wife of the late Robert Edward Brooks who predeceased her in 1959. From that time, Mrs. Brooks devoted herself to the successful raising and education of her three children and her career as a pharmacist. She made her home in Longview from 1960 until 1976 when she returned to Carthage.
