She faced each circumstance as a growing opportunity. She was and is a true

warrior. Warrior: A brave, or experienced soldier or fighter. There is no truer description of her. She has fought through every season of her life so faithfully. Kayla got her fairytale ending when she stumbled across her cowboy, Corey Turner. They built a beautiful life and family together on the Turner Ranch over the last 8 years. The love that is shared between the two of them is indescribable and there was no denying that Christ was in the center of their story.

Temporarily, she leaves behind her husband and best friend, Corey Turner, along with their adored children, Cambrie and Keaton; her mother, Sharon Kirchner Brown and husband Donny Brown; her father Gary Lee and wife, Sandra Gill Lee; along with her biological father, Bill Fisher and wife Amanda; her sister, Amelia Nieves and husband, Lexi; her father-in-law and mother-in-law, Brian and Melissa Turner; her brother-in-law and sister-in-law, Ryan and Hali Westbrook; along with a number of nieces and nephews who loved her dearly and referred to her along with many others as KK.
