Ollie Lanell Evans Jernigan, affectionately known as Mama Nell or Granny, peacefully passed away on December 3, 2023, at the age of 87 at her home in Panola, Texas. 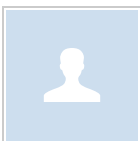
