Mrs. Lee Esther Mae Labeaux Spencer-Lovingood, 97, passed on July 5, 2018 in Carthage, TX. She was born on November 28, 1920 in New Iberia, LA. She was the first born of ten children to Robert Labeaux, Sr. and Louelva Hayes Labeaux.

She was baptized Catholic and was educated at Hebert High School in Beaumont, TX. She moved to San Francisco, CA in the early 1940's. She married Edward Spencer 1939 and later divorced.
