Mr. Lee Bridges Scott was born February 28, 1962 in Phoenix, Arizona. He was one of two children born to the marriage of Lawrence Bertram and Lois Morrison Scott. Lee spent his babyhood in Phoenix and Long Island City, New York. When his family moved to Carthage, he attended Libby Elementary, Carthage Junior High and graduated from Carthage High School in 1980. After high school, Lee enlisted in the U.S. Navy and served as an engineer on the U.S.S. Fanning (FF-1076), a fast frigate decommissioned in 1993. He attended Texas A&M University and worked as a grocery store department manager for HEB Grocery in Bryan, Texas. Lee fought Multiple Sclerosis for almost twenty years, and died from complications of this disease. His greatest joys in life were being a father and sharing his Christian faith with others. He was a member of Southside Baptist Church in Carthage.

Lee is survived by his ex-wife, Lorrie Scott; his son, Logan Scott; his stepson, Dusty Windham; his sister, Lisa Scott Oltmans and husband Michael. He was preceded in death by his parents Lawrence Bertram Scott and Lois Morrison Scott.
