



## Mrs. Linda Lee Snow

July 28, 1948 - June 23, 2016

Linda Snow, beloved wife and mother, 67, of Tenaha, TX, lost her battle with lung cancer and passed to eternal life with her savior, Jesus Christ our Lord, at 10:30 a. m., Thursday, June 23, 2016. She passed peacefully at home under Hospice Care.

Born Linda Lee Proctor to Herman Woodrow and Cona Von Sie Walling Proctor, on July 28th, 1948 in Galveston, TX, she graduated high school from Ramstein High in Ramstein, Germany.

Linda became the loving wife of Marvin Snow on September 25th, 1971 and began raising their children on March 15, 1977. She became active in church activities shortly thereafter and became a positive influence on not only her own, but many other children over the thirty-nine years of service to various churches and Christian-oriented organizations throughout East Texas.
