Mrs. LeBlanc worked for Hawthorn Life Insurance and was a charter member of the Hawthorn Funeral Home Ladies Auxiliary, was active in her city and community. 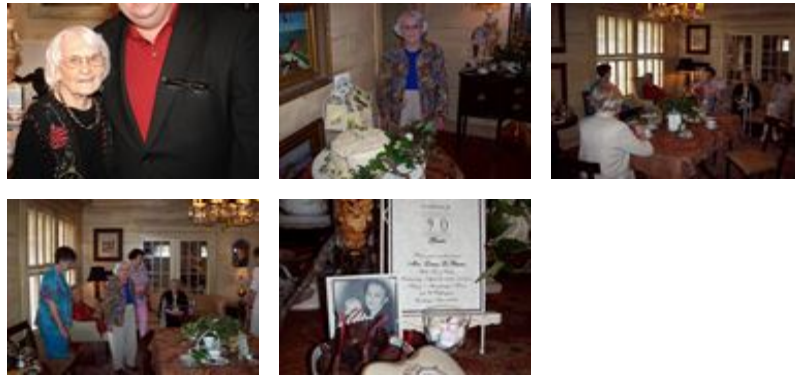
