



Mrs. Lucille Granberry Gholston

October 20, 1921 - June 8, 2017

Lucille Granberry Gholston passed away peacefully on June 8, 2017 at the age of 95. Services will be at 11:00 a.m., Monday, June 12, 2017 in the Hawthorn Funeral Home Chapel with Rev. Keefe Cropper officiating. Burial will follow in the Odd Fellows Cemetery under the direction of Hawthorn Funeral Home. The family will receive friends from 4-6:00 p.m. Sunday at the funeral home.

Lucille was born in Celeste, Texas on October 20, 1921. She and her twin sister, Lorraine Lovell, were the youngest of seven children of Samuel Rodney and Chloe Estelle Granberry. Lucille graduated as Valedictorian of her class in Celeste and attended Tarleton State College before moving to Beckville for her first job in 1940 as an employee of Peoples State Bank. She married Noble Eugene Gholston on December 25, 1941. She also worked before and after living in Washington at First State Bank in Carthage. From 1953 to 1959, Lucille and her husband owned and managed a local credit bureau, the Retail Merchants Association. Lucille went to work for the First National Bank of Carthage (now Farmers State Bank) in 1959 and retired as a senior vice-president in 1989 after 30 years with the bank. She was an active member of the First United Methodist Church of Carthage and enjoyed many volunteer activities through the church.

Lucille was preceded in death by her husband, Noble Eugene Gholston, also her parents, Samuel Rodney and Chloe Estelle Granberry; four brothers, T.C. Granberry, Robert Granberry, Albert Granberry, and Clifford Granberry; and

one sister, Mary Ruth Granberry.

Survivors include daughters, Linda Gholston Thomas and Karen Gholston Javellana and husband Butch; twin sister, Lorraine Lovell; granddaughters Amy Thomas Gerling and husband Paul, Dina Thomas Castranova and husband Rich, Keri Harvey McKinney and husband Billy; and seven great-grandchildren, Thomas Paul Gerling, John Austin Gerling, Linda Ann Castranova, Samuel Joseph Castranova, Margaret Maurine (Maggie) Castranova, William Noble McKinney, and Jack Reed McKinney.
