



## Madie Lou Jimerson

August 12, 1914 - March 12, 2013

Funeral services for Mrs. Madie Lou Jimerson, 98, of Houston, TX, formerly of Madisonville, TX and Gary, TX will be 2:00p.m., Friday, March 15, 2013 at the Hawthorn Funeral Home Chapel with Chaplain Pete Williams officiating. Madie Lou died on March 12, 2013 in Houston, Texas.

She grew up in the Buncombe community and met and married Martin Kersh on April 22, 1933 in Panola County. Madie Lou and Martin had one child, Jerry Graves Kersh. Upon Martin's death, Madie raised Jerry and worked at the Carthage State Bank. The Graves family loved music and sang and participated in local gospel meetings. At one of these gospel singings, Madie Lou met Robert Lewis Jimerson. Madie Lou and Robert married on March 16, 1954 and had one child, Jennifer Jimerson.

Madie Lou spent over forty years as an active member of the First Baptist Church of Madisonville Texas. She utilized her contralto voice to sing in the choir and continued to sing in duets and quartets with Robert as well as an active past President of the WMU and teach a Sunday School Class. Being creative and loving crafts, Madie Lou became known as an excellent

seamstress and spent the last of her working career sewing and altering clothes.

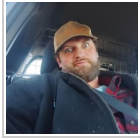

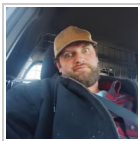

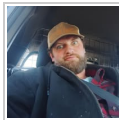
