Mrs. Martha Ann Foster Harness was born September 26, 1936 in Oklahoma City, OK. She passed this life October 30, 2021 peacefully at her Carthage, Texas home. She was raised in Oklahoma City, later graduating from Shawnee High School with the class of 1954.
