



## Mrs. Martha H. Whitaker

Funeral services for Martha H. Whitaker, 87, of Carthage will be held at 10:00 a.m. Tuesday, March 1, 2022, at Rehobeth United Methodist Church, Carthage, Texas, with the Rev. Martha H. Whitaker was born the only daughter and youngest child of Walter O. and Stella B. Hancock at home in Gregg County, Texas on November 26, 1934. Her passion was teaching special education children and she excelled at finding the unique way each child learned best, making a life-long difference in their lives. After more than 30 years of teaching, Mrs. Whitaker retired in 2003 from Carthage Independent School District.

Mrs. Whitaker married Bill R. Whitaker on November 28, 1959, at Rehobeth United Methodist Church in Carthage, Texas. Together they celebrated nearly 50 years of marriage. A long-time active member of Rehobeth, she enjoyed creating floral arrangements for her church family. Mrs. Whitaker was also an

avid gardener and accomplished seamstress.

Mrs. Whitaker is survived by her loving daughter, Angela Whitaker of Houston, Texas; her sister-in-law, Jo Hancock of Kilgore, Texas; and numerous nieces and nephews.

She was preceded in death by her husband, Bill R. Whitaker, infant daughter, Laura Lynn Whitaker; both parents; and brothers, JD Hancock, Edward Hancock, and George Beene.

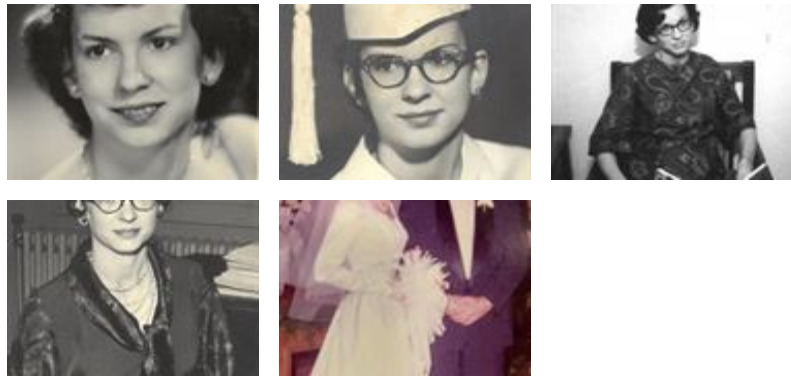
