Mr. Robert Mondee Adams was born May 5, 1925 in Gary, Texas to James Harvey and Anabel Heaton Adams. The second of four children, Mondee was schooled in Gary, graduating with Gary High School. He then served his country through the US Navy, later attending Stephen F. Austin University. Mondee married Lelma Ernestene Mims on June 22, 1946 in Timpson, Texas and they celebrated 63 years of marriage until her death in 2009. Mr. Adams worked for United Gas Pipeline and Pennzoil, retiring after 30 years of service. A member of First Baptist Church of Carthage, he was a faithful member of the Berean Sunday School Class and served as a deacon for many years. Mondee was a devoted father and grandfather and was fondly referred to as “Papa” by all that loved him. Mr. Adams was an avid supporter of all the activities and sports his grandchildren and great grandchildren were involved in. “Papa” was known for his 42 playing and his love for hunting and fishing.
