Mr. Henigan was born January 5, 1923 in Carthage, Texas to the marriage of Luther M. Henigan and Maude Angeline Morris Henigan. He was the youngest of eleven siblings. Neal began school in Carthage, but graduated from Hallsville High School where, beginning at the age of fourteen, he played on Hallsville's first football team. He held the position of starting quarterback throughout his high school career, making a name for himself throughout the Texas area. After graduating on July 20, 1940, he married Doyle Bardwell. They celebrated 70 years of marriage. Neal served his Country in the United States Army Signal Corp, and in March of 1984, he retired after 37 years with Amoco Production Company.
