Mrs. Nerina Angela Comuzzi Bell was born on September 30, 1930, in Udine, Italy. She passed this life on May 5, 2023, in Carthage, Texas. Nerina was born to the marriage of Adelchi and Esther Peron Comuzzi. She was raised and schooled in Italy. Nerina married William Beecher Bell on October 5, 1946, and they celebrated 52 years of marriage before he preceded her in death in 1999.
