Mrs. Williams was a high school teacher where she taught Business Education, Biology, Science and Physical Education in the Caddo Parish School System for 41 years until her retirement in 1984. She was a member of Bel Air Baptist Church in Marshall for many years. Mrs. Williams is preceded in death by her parents and her brother, Brown Franklin Kimbell.
