A Christian Funeral Mass for Mr. Philip Edward Scholl, 55 of DeBerry, Texas will be at 11:00 a.m., Monday, April 13, 2015 at St. William of Vercelli Catholic Church with Father Jesudoss Thomas officiating. A Rosary will be held at 10:30 a.m. prior to the service. Mr. Scholl passed away Friday, April 10, 2015 in Longview, Texas.

Mr. Philip Edward Scholl was born November 24, 1959 in Pennsylvania. He was one of three boys born to the marriage of Earl Eugene and Alice Mae Emrick Scholl. Philip attended schools in Utah graduating from Clearfield High School with the class of 1977. He then went on to further his education at Weaver State University graduating with a degree in Mathematics with a minor in Physics and Computer Science. Philip met and later married Deborah Lynn Kozerski on March 17, 1984 celebrating 31 years of marriage. Mr. Scholl worked over 15 years at Panola College as a professor and a facilitator in the testing lab as well as the library.

Philip was a member of the St. Williams of Vercelli Catholic Church where he was the president of the Legion of Mary and a 4th Degree Knight of Columbus. He was a true audiophile, loved astronomy and model trains. Philip is preceded in death by his parents and brothers, Allen Eugene and Timothy Eugene.
