He attended Carthage schools graduating with the Class of 1951, and then attended Panola Jr. College. Phillip met and later married Frances Juaneen McCarty on July 1, 1953 and together they celebrate almost 63 years of marriage. He worked as a plumber and heating contractor, owning and operating Phillip Crump, Inc. Phillip was a founder, organizer and deacon of New Hope Baptist Church and volunteered with the Christian Builders. He was a licensed pilot and loved to fish and travel all across the US, Canada and Alaska. Phillip was preceded in death by his parents and a brother, Bobby Allen Crump,
