Mr. Phillip Lynn Walker was born July 28, 1954 in Center, Texas. He went to be with the Lord Tuesday, January 4, 2022 peacefully at his Logan, Texas home. Lynn was one of four children born to the marriage of John Melgon and O.D. Juanita Baker Walker. He was schooled in Logansport, Louisiana graduating with the class of 1972.
