



## Rev. H.P. Long

June 4, 1929 - July 7, 2012

Funeral services for Rev. H. P. Long, 83 of Carthage, Texas will be 3:00 p.m., Tuesday, July 10, 2012 at the Carthage United Pentecostal Church with Rev. Ricky Jeane, Rev. Jeff Story and Rev. Rev. Huey Pierce Long was born June 4, 1929 in Mira, Louisiana. He was one of nine children born to the marriage of Ernest Clifton and Rose Adcock Long. Rev. Long attended McLeod schools and graduated from McLeod High School with the class of 1946. He met the love of his life, Bertie Mason while teaching music for the Stamps Music Schools and they were married on December 22, 1946 and celebrated 65 years together. Rev. Long also worked in the oilfield industry and many other trades throughout his life. However, his passion was ministering the word of God. Rev.
