Shirley you have proved to be that excellent wife to Don as described in Proverbs Chapter 31.

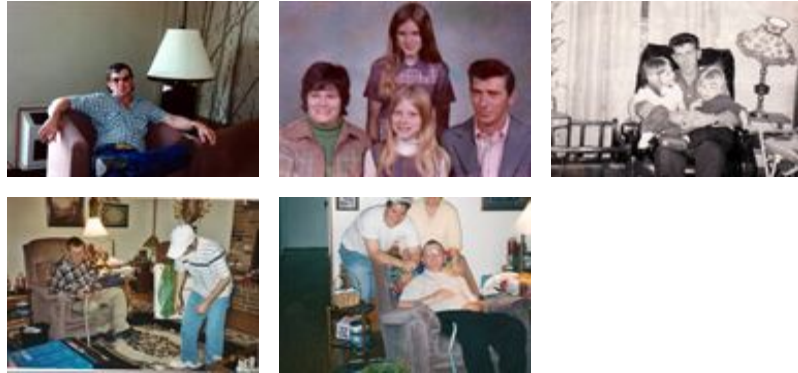
