Mr. Richard Andrew “Rich” Boelter was born August 26, 1967, in Oconomowoc, Wisconsin. He passed this life October 21, 2025, at his Beckville, Texas home.

Richard was the third of five children born to the marriage of Barbara Ann Gauerke and Gerald Roger Boelter. He was raised and schooled in Oconomowoc graduating with the high school class of 1985. He went on to graduate with a Bachelor of Psychology through the University of Wisconsin in Madison and obtained his nursing degree through the Panola College of nursing.

Mr. Boelter spent his career in Nursing through Good Shepherd beginning in 2005. Rich was a light to his profession through his care and compassion, concern for coworkers and nurturing and mentoring new nurses. He dedicated these last ten years to patients in the ICU.

Rich was a member of the Cypress Valley Bible Church. He was known as “Big Papa”, loved time with family and friends cooking, gardening, bird watching and following the Packers, Brewers and Bucks. He was quick witted and quick to remind you “I’m kind of a big deal.” He is preceded in death by

his parents.

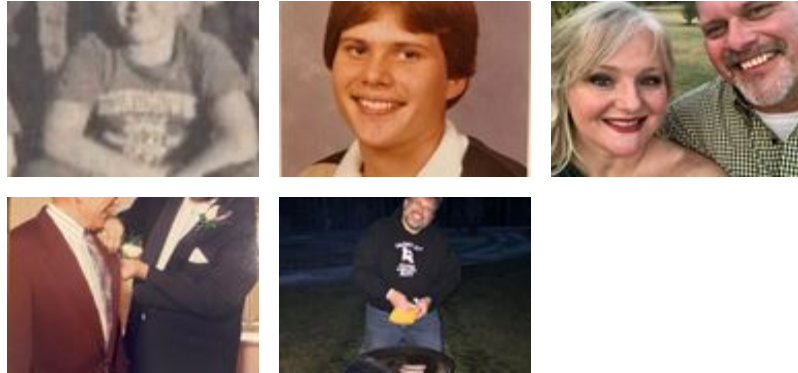

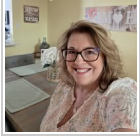

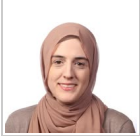
