Mr. Richard Gray Reed was born June 27, 1924 in Clayton, Texas. He was the middle child of three born to the marriage of Robert Wilson and Katie Mae Gray Reed. He was raised and schooled in Clayton and graduated from Carthage High School. He served his country through the U.S. Army in Japan at the end of WWII.
