



Rev. Robert Duane "R.D." Heflin

Funeral services for Rev. Robert Duane Heflin (R. D.) will be 3:00 p.m. Sunday, December 22, 2013 at the Hawthorn Funeral Home Chapel with Rev. Robert Easterling officiating. Heflin died December 14, 2013 in Costa Rica.

Rev. Robert Duane "R.D." Heflin was born near Hollis, Oklahoma April 25, 1930 to Robert Martin and Mattie James Heflin, who preceded him in death. Duane graduated from Ron High School, Hollis, Oklahoma, Jacksonville College, Jacksonville, Texas, East Texas Baptist College, Marshall, Texas and the BMA Theological Seminary, Jacksonville, Texas. He pastored churches in Jewett, Henderson, Amarillo, Plainview, Lubbock and Port Neches, all in Texas. He went, with his family, in 1962 to serve as missionary of the BMA of America and had served over 51 years there, where he was residing at his death.
