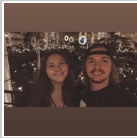

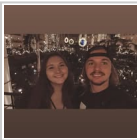

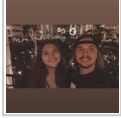
“ I remember him coming to DeBerry when I worked for his mom Betty Sue and his brother Gary D. Prayers his family
