Wallace attended Carthage schools graduating from Beckville High School with the class of 1956. Having served two years in the reserve he entered the U.S. Air Force in 1956 serving during the Vietnam War as a staff sergeant retiring in 1976. Mr. Ebarb was a member of the North Shore Baptist Church, American Legion and lifetime member of both the V.F.W. and D.A.V. 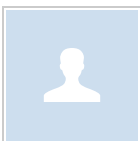
